

2023 Monday Night Ladies Scramble League Rules

Season 2023: Starts Monday May 1st.

No Play on May 29th, and September 4th. Final Outing and Banquet on September 11th.

Tee Off Time: 4:30 to 5:30pm. Please let the opposing team know what time you will arrive the week prior.

Dues: \$85.00 per player. May be paid in full first week or \$45.00 the first week and \$40.00 due by July 11th. Please make checks payable to Linda Swartout. Any league questions ask Linda Swartout.

Handicaps: Will be figured at 90% on the team score. The first week handicap will be calculated after golf. Handicaps will be averaged based on the numbers of weeks played.

Format: Two-person scramble. Both tee off, take the best shot and both hit from that spot determined to best till the hole is finished. Hole is finished when the first member putts out. You play your ball where it lies. Your partner has the option of placing their ball within six inches of the second shot but not closer to the pin. DO NOT MOVE your ball from the rough into the fair way at any time.

Subs: It is your responsibility to arrange for a sub to play in your absence. If your TEAM is not able to play, please let the opposing team know as quickly as possible. Make sure you speak with a member of the opposing team. Please do not leave a voice mail and or leave a message at the pro shop.

Weather: Show up for play, rain, or shine. In case of bad weather, a decision will be made by the golf course as to option of play.

Added Rules: If a team is unable to play a schedule date, and the opponents have been notified verbally that you will not be able to play, the playing team may check to see if there is another twosome that they can play with that evening. If you are unable to find another team to play with and you know that the scheduled team cannot play, then you may as a twosome but must be as a last resort. If you or your partner is unable to secure a sub you may have the option of shooting two balls. Discuss with your opponent's your intent before play. If you chose to hit two balls and decide you do not want the second shot, this will be allowable.

No Penalty: For hitting the flag unattended. You can leave flag in or out while putting.

Dropping Ball: Your Ball must be let go from the knee height & fall through the air without touching any part of your body and or equipment.

Embedded Ball: Relief is allowed without penalty for embedded ball anywhere (except in the sand) general area of course all the way to the green.
